Fish Shocking

Each spring and fall fish, populations are monitored using electro-fishing methods on the Preserve to determine the species composition and fish densities in Preserve streams.*

Frog-call Surveys

Spring surveys will be conducted to determine where frogs are calling on the Preserve to identify breeding sites and population densities.*
